# What do we have to do?

- Before each visit each host country will create four case studies (maximum 2 sides of A4)
- Before each transnational meeting the host will book hotels or suggest accommodation.
- Do four case studies and arrange to visit them, organise transport
- Organise a meeting room to analyse the case studies, suggest additions and improvements.

# Transnational visits.

- Visit 4 social farming enterprises and have professional discussions, evaluating each one.
- At the end of the project, all case studies will be shared widely through the creation of a booklet and 'on line' set of case studies as part of a website and Facebook page.
- Five visits, three in the first year, two in year two.
- Record activities and project results onto WEBGATE and ERASMUS + Project platform.

# Impact

- A final multiplier event in the UK in year two.
- A website with a page about each partner, their role, their association and some case studies.
- A Facebook page which shares ideas and innovation.
- A booklet containing 20 case studies highlighting how social farming can impact on people, measuring and maximising social impact.

- A doctor of psychology is now 10 months into researching WELLIES.
